401. SPECIAL REVERSED CHARGE SERVICE (ENTERPRISE)

.1 GENERAL

- .1.1 This service provides an arrangement whereby subscribers to private branch exchange, Centrex or one party service (excepting coin box service) may offer their patrons the privilege of calling them at their expense without having to request specific acceptance of the charge.
- .1.2 The exchanges in which such service is furnished may be selected by the subscribers, subject to the approval of the Company, and the Company assigns a special telephone number for the service. Calls for the special telephone number are accepted only when originated in the exchange with which the special number is associated, and the subscriber assumes the charges for all calls for the special number.
- .1.3 The rates and regulations of New England Telephone Company apply to this interchange service.

402. MESSAGE TOLL TELEPHONE SERVICE

.1 GENERAL

.1.1 For all calls originating on the lines or facilities of this Company and interchanged or interconnected with the facilities of other companies, the rates and regulations of New England Telephone and Telegraph Company will apply.

.1.2 Calls originating from the Mt. Vernon, 293 exchange to the Augusta, Belgrade, Livermore Falls, Readfield and Farmington exchanges and calls originating from the Monmouth 933 exchange to the Lewiston exchange and calls originating from the Litchfield 268 exchange to the Lewiston exchange will not be included in the following optional calling plans, Selective Calling Services, Pine Tree State Calling Service, NETSAVER, NETSAVER PLUS, Business Link.

.1.3 When a customer requests full rate charge detail displayed on their bill for each call made under any bulk optional calling plan, a monthly charge of \$.50 per billed number applies.

.2.1 SELECTIVE CALLING SERVICE

Selective Calling Service is offered to Community Service Telephone Company customers as a Message Toll Service and all rates and regulations of New England Telephone & Telegraph Co. as filed in their Tariff PUC – ME – No. 15 Part A – Message Toll Section 9 shall apply. Future revisions of said Tariff shall also apply.

.2.2 Calling Areas

.5 MESSAGE TOLL TELEPHONE SERVICE FOR DISABLED PERSONS

.5.1 Message Toll Telephone Service For disabled persons is offered to Community Service Telephone Company customers as a Message Toll Service and all rates and regulations of New England Telephone & Telegraph Co. as filed in their Tariff, P.U.C. – Me. No. 15, Part A Message Toll, Section 9 shall apply. Future revisions of said Tariff shall also apply.

402. MESSAGE TOLL TELEPHONE SERVICE (Cont'd)

.6 PINE TREE STATE CALLING SERVICE

.6.1 Pine Tree State Calling Service is offered to Community Service Telephone Company customers as a Message Toll Service and all rates and regulations of New England Telephone & Telegraph Co. as filed in their tariff, P.U.C. Me. No. 15, Part A. Message Telecommunications Service, Section 9 shall apply. Future revisions of said tariff shall also apply.

.6.2 Pine Tree State Calling Service is offered in all exchanges as a supplement to one party residence main telephone exchange service.

Note. Calls originating from the Mt. Vernon, 293 exchange to the Augusta exchange and calls originating from the Monmouth 933 exchange to the Lewiston exchange and calls originating from the Litchfield 268 exchange to the Lewiston exchange are not eligible for Pine Tree State Calling Service.

402. MESSAGE TOLL TELEPHONE SERVICE (Cont'd)

9.8 NETSAVER CALLING SERVICE

9.8.1 GENERAL

- A. NETSAVER Calling Service offers customers the option of paying a specific monthly rate to obtain a discount, specified in 9.8.3. B. and C. following, that is applied to the billed monthly revenue for the following calls made during all rate periods to any Message Telecommunication Service point within the State of Maine LATA:
1. Customer dialed station – to – station sent – paid calls
  2. Operator – completed station – to – station sent-paid calls, if facilities are not available for customer – dialed completion
  3. Operator handled station – to – station sent- paid calls for handicapped persons unable to dial calls because of their handicap
- B. NETSAVER Calling Service is offered in all exchanges and localities, subject to the availability of facilities, as a supplement to one or two party residence or business main telephone exchange service, trunk lines and Centrex service lines.
- C. NETSAVER Calling Service is not available:
1. With Selective Calling Service and Pine Tree State Service
  2. For person – to – person, collect, charge to a Calling Card number, charge to a third telephone number, conference, or other calls that normally require an operator
  3. With Public Access Line (PAL) service
  4. On FX service
  5. With Dormitory Communications Service

9.8.2 APPLICATION OF RATES AND CHARGES

- A. The NETSAVER Calling Service monthly rate applies for all exchange lines associated with a billing telephone number.
- B. The NETSAVER Calling Service monthly rate applies whether or not the customer makes any calls
- C. The minimum payment period for NETSAVER Calling Service is one month.

402. MESSAGE TOLL TELEPHONE SERVICE (Cont'd)

.7 DEEP DISCOUNT EXTENDED COMMUNITY CALLING SERVICE PLAN

.7.1 GENERAL REGULATIONS

.7.1.1 Deep Discount Extended Community Calling Service Plan is an optional calling service whereby customers may call other specified exchanges at reduced rates.

.7.1.2 Deep Discount Extended Community Calling Service Plan rates apply only to customer dialed station – to – station sent-paid calls and operator-completed station – to – station sent-paid calls when facilities are not available for customer dial completion. The rates also apply to operator completed station – to – station sent-paid calls for handicapped persons unable to dial calls because of their handicap.

7.1.3 Deep Discount Extended Community Calling Service Plans are not available:

1. On foreign exchange service
2. For person – to – person, collect, charge to a calling card number, conference, or other calls that normally require an operator.

.7.1.4 Extended Community Calling Service Plan rates and charges are in addition to the rates and charges for the associated Local Access Line and other associated charges.

.7.1.5 Non-recurring charges specified in 7.2.6 following do not apply when Extended Community Calling Service Plans are ordered in conjunction with Local Telephone Service for which a Service Connection Charge as specified in Section 325 applies.

.7 DEEP DISCOUNT EXTENDED COMMUNITY CALLING SERVICE PLAN (Cont'd)

.7.2 GENERAL REGULATIONS (Cont'd)

.7.2.1 Deep Discount Extended Community Calling Service Plan provides thirty minutes per month of cumulative message time of customer dialed calls placed to exchanges, zones and localities not exceeding 30 airline miles. Calls made under Deep Discount Extended Community Calling Plans are billed without regard to the date or time of day. Calling areas are as specified below.

.7.2.2 Deep Discount Extended Community Calling Service Plans are available to both residence and business customers.

7.2.3 Customers with more than one access line must have the Deep Discount Extended Community Calling Service Plan on all lines that are located on the same premises.

7.2.4 Accumulation of message time is done on a whole minute basis. Individual messages with fractional totals are rounded to the next higher minute.
